

# The “Enemy at the Gate” Vulnerability Spread

1. Select the “Opportunity” card in advance to represent what is at stake in the matter. Use a second deck for this card and the “quints.”
2. Deal the first deck into alternating row positions 1-8. Reversals may be used to show quirks or nuances that favor one party or the other.
3. Compare positional cards to determine which party has the “advantage” in each position. Score +1 per advantage, null per tie.
4. Sum and reduce the four positional cards in each row and assess the “quints” for “favor” or “disfavor” in the overall success outlook. Score +1 for favor, null for tie. “Favor” can be shown by numerical, elemental and astrological sign or planet parallels between the “quints” and the “line” cards. Populate the “Sub-Quint” score boxes accordingly.
5. Sum and reduce the two “sub-quints” to derive the “Grand Quintessence,” and determine which party it favors. Score +2 for advantage, null for tie. Populate the Grand Quint score boxes accordingly.
6. Populate the remaining “raw score” boxes and calculate the Grand Totals. Best chance for success goes to the highest score.
7. The lines for “self” and “opponent” can be changed to “Opponent #1” and “Opponent #2 when not reading for oneself.
